

2018 Tamaraw Month Shadow Play Competition

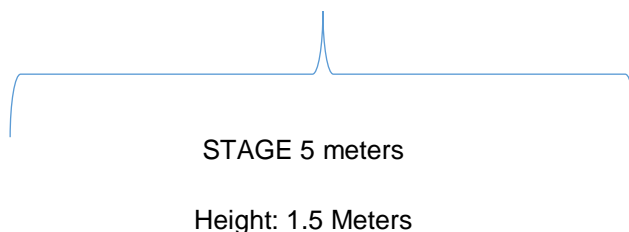
Shadow play interpretative dance competition focuses on the interplay of the dramatic elements of theater and interpretative dance, choreography and storytelling.

- a. **Participants.** All public and private high schools (Grade 7-12) in Mindoro Island are encouraged to join.
- b. The **theme** of the performance should focus on any ***cultural beliefs and practices of their specific locality in Mindoro Island with regards to the Tamaraws and its conservation.***
- c. **Script** should be an original work of the student-participants and shall not infringe on any copyrights/rights of any third parties.

A copy of typewritten scripts with the title, name of the writer/s and name of performer/s must be submitted on or before **August 24, 2018** through our email: ***info@mbcfi.org.ph*** with the subject and filename: ***Script_City/Municipality_Name of school (e.g. Script_Rizal_Manoot National HS)***

- d. **Registration** form to be submitted on or before **August 24, 2018** to our email: ***info@mbcfi.org.ph*** with the subject and filename: ***Registration_City/Municipality_Name of school (e.g. Registration_Rizal_Manoot National HS)***
- e. **Elimination Round** (Online Submission of Video)
 1. There will only be one entry per school.
 2. A maximum of 15 students are allowed to participate per entry, regardless of sex/gender.
 3. The coach is only allowed to assist the students during script writing and the setting up of materials.
 4. Each entry should only run for 5-7 minutes. One (1) point will be deducted for any difference from the time range allotted.
 5. Song/s that will be used during the performance must be in Filipino and/or English.
 6. Props (special effects, colored lights, overhead projector, etc.) should be provided by the participants.
 7. It should be accompanied by music and sound effects
 8. It should be in the form of interpretative dance
 9. Final video must be submitted to MBCFI ***on or before September 14, 2018.*** Videos will be posted starting September 17 until September 30, 2018 for voting purposes.
 10. **All video entries will be judged accordingly and five finalists** will be shortlisted.
- f. **Final Round** (Live Performance)
 1. Five finalists will be performing live on October 12, 2018 in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.
 2. A maximum of 15 students are allowed to participate per entry, regardless of sex/gender.
 3. Participants may be accompanied by one coach. However, the coach is only allowed to assist the students during the setting up of materials and not during the performance proper.
 4. Each entry should only run for 10-15 minutes including set-up, actual performance and exit. Actual performance should be 5-7 minutes only. One (1) point will be deducted for any difference from the time range allotted.
 5. Song/s that will be used during the performance must be in Filipino and/or English.
 6. Props (special effects, colored lights, overhead projector, etc.) should be provided by the participants.
 7. The same script, music and choreography from the elimination round should be used. Changes will result to 1 point deduction.

8. It should be accompanied by music and sound effects.
9. It should be in the form of interpretative dance.
10. Venue: **San Jose, Occidental Mindoro**
11. Date: **October 12, 2018**



g. Criteria for Judging

1. Story (Clarity and Narrative Flow)	20%
2. Relevance to Environmental Issues	20%
3. Production Design	15%
4. Characterization and Choreography	15%
5. Technique (Use of props, timing, musical scoring)	15%
6. Originality	15%
